

REPORT ON THE IAP/APESP-(Brazilian Division of the Pathology-State of São Paulo) and IAP Latin American Assembly

This education programme was held in São Paulo city, on June 6 and 7, 2014, in the Federal University of the city of Paulo (Boris Casoy amphitheatre). This was the 255th Apesp Meeting, and it was the first time that was sponsored by IAP.

The invited speaker was Dr. Liliana Olvi, an Argetinian pathologist working in the lab. of Dr. Eduardo Santini, in Buenos Aires. The activities emphasized the diagnoses of soft tissue tumors:

- Friday evening: General diagnoses of the soft tissue tumors in two conferences (40 min, each).
- Saturday morning: A conference on tumors with a myxoid component.
- Saturday afternoon: Discussion on 10 cases of labs. of Brazilian surgical pathologists, presented by our residents.

The participants from all over Brazil were numerous (over 90 pathologists) (see pictures attached).

The Apesp meetings are planned annually, with 6-7 meetings, since 1980.

Altogether this was a very positive meeting for our iAP Division and we hope to have many others.

The present activity was organized by the Apesp President: Dr. Renato Lima de Moraes and by Dr. Ricardo Artigiani and Dr Marcello Franco, participants of the Latin American Assembly, Brazilian members.

The very successful result of this event will be an important stimulus for the organization of new and similar events, acting under the guidance and supervision of the recently elect new president of the IAP. Dr. Eduardo Santini.
